Neel and I went to not Marie and Rome to see Aire. It helped a tot and it was great to talk to someone who know the problems we note going through.

When Marie contacted me about S.D.F., I was delighted to get involved - I feel. If we can help families of newly diagnosed Petro's Syndrome bubbles it will be great.

Our first meeting was on the 15th September 1991 and our second on the 9th November 1991. All of as inspired are very endustratic about the Justice of S.D.F.T. Ireland.

Our meeting on the 9th November was a great ruccess and we elected our officient
